#### **Narratives**

#### **Disaster Damage:**

Over the past two years, Texas has experienced major disaster events — including numerous floods, tornadoes, and wildfires — that have produced six disaster declarations spread over 160 of the state's 254 counties. The Texas counties impacted represent 76 percent of the Texas population, or 20.9 million people — a population greater than that of 48 states. In particular, the recent 2016 events were devastating, killing 29 Texans and causing significantly more public and private property damage due to the compounding effects of the 2015 floods.

The Texas General Land Office estimates a combined loss of over \$2 billion in unmet long-term recovery need, given the impact of the multiple disasters suffered by Texas in both 2015 and 4 | Page 2016. Impacts tied to business interruption, economic losses, unemployment, property tax revenue decreases, agricultural losses, and other measures that are difficult to quantify, are not considered when allocations are made. The 2016 flooding and devastation spanning from March to June resulted in three qualifying events for appropriation under Public Laws 114-223 and 114-254

On April 17, 2016 (DR-4269) Texas was hit with a sixth catastrophic rain event over a 12-month period, initiating a rare flash flood "emergency warning" by the National Weather Service's Houston/Galveston Weather Forecast Office. The rare warning criteria was on target, given the consequences to a highly vulnerable population. The severe flooding greatly affected first responders' abilities to assist residents and, in some instances, even required the rescue of first responders themselves. Parts of Southeast Texas received 10

inches or more of rain during a 24-hour period, with the heaviest rainfall occurring north and west of Houston.3 The devastating floods covered the seven counties. The president approved the governor's Major Disaster Declaration on April 25, 2016, with Amendment #1

issued on May 2, 2016, and Amendment #2 on May 9, 2016.

#### **Recovery Needs:**

The state will be focusing on the variety of data that help provide a comprehensive understanding of the unmet need across Texas in the housing and non-housing sectors. Given the extent of counties impacted by the disasters, a part of the unmet need calculations was determined using data provided by the Texas Division of Emergency Management (TDEM) for all applicants. These data come from the Emergency Management Mission Integrated Environment (EMMIE) database. The total projected cost for damages tied to the 2016 disasters is \$201,341,450. This results in the state's unmet need from public assistance totaling \$57,885,667 with a resiliency multiplier of 15 percent.

The data for housing unmet needs comes from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) and the National Emergency Management Information System (NEMIS) database. For the three disaster declarations in 2016, the total FEMA Verified Loss (FVL) is \$186,361,160. The state's unmet need relating to FEMA Individual Assistance (IA) is \$88,131,592 with a resilience multiplier of 15 percent. The figure for unmet need was calculated by FEMA as being FVL minus all assistance provided through the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP), FEMA housing assistance, and Small Business Administration (SBA) assistance, as well as other assistance that could be accounted for.

The unmet need, as identified by the SBA using the total verified loss of households and businesses, is \$309,254,300 for housing and \$104,720,409 for businesses. These figures also take into consideration a resilience multiplier of 15 percent totaling \$40,337,517 for housing data and \$13,659,184 for business data. FEMA and SBA data alone yield an unmet need for the state of Texas totaling \$559,991,968.

A comprehensive review of activity descriptions and location descriptions, resulting in updates for the descriptions for the majority of activities in order to be more consistent and concise.

#### Houston - Buyout Program

During the reporting period, 1 project was 100% complete, 1 project 95% complete, 1 project at 85% complete, 1 project at 20% complete, 1 project at 10% complete and 1 project was issued NTP.

#### Affordable Rental Program

Madisonville is 50% constructed at time of reporting, projected to complete construction in Q1 2022. Cross Plains still in planning phase and expecting to receive AUGF in Q4 2021.

GLO's efforts to expedite implementation and expenditures

#### Subrecipient - Housing/Infrastructure Programs

"For 2016 the housing programs, most of the costs will come at the end when homeowners begin receiving payouts, the expenditures skew toward the end of the program even if the program is being executed rapidly. There are a few â¿¿Urgent Needâ¿ buyouts which, like in the 2015 case, were a second priority to Low to Moderate Income activities. There are additional issues that can drive down the expenditure percentages.

In the case of Pasadena, the grant is â¿¿construction onlyâ¿ i.e., the administrative, environmental, and engineering costs were entirely paid by the community and their construction has only just begun. Similarly, Montgomery County is self-administering and most of the funds for it so far have been drawn locally. Jersey Village and Montgomery County had an extended environmental clearance process which involved FEMA.

Ft. Bend Co has seen multiple roadblocks, because of Covid there was a personnel shortage for the municipality which delayed environmental reviews, and among private companies which delayed appraisals and inspections.

Missouri City has a relatively small project that involved extensive negotiation with the Harris County Flood Control District. There were supply chain delays in the proprietary flood gauges. Additionally, since this is a relatively small grant, the city is planning on submitting for the complete amount when all work is complete.

Any delays so far have also been compounded by the context of COVID. As we stated above human resources were hit at multiple levels, appraisers, construction personnel particularly in Fort Bend County, but itâ¿¿s applicable in most jurisdictions. Compounding that was the deep freeze earlier in this year which really constrained personnel and material resources. Our countermeasures for projects that execute their budgets slowly is to provide TA and meetings on the importance of steadily submitting draws.

Some of the delays are due to amendments taking multiple months and we have reworked our amendment process internally to the GLO and hope to expedite that element. For projects that that are particularly far behind, our Monitoring Team distributes quarterly â¿¿Timely Expendituresâ¿ letters which caution the subrecipient directly that they are behind in budget execution and will need to accelerate their processes. The GM team uses these letters as an opportunity to follow up with the sub-recipients and offer them strategies for accelerating the execution of their programs."

Harris County - Housing/Infrastructure Programs

Harris County has identified three buyout families who are working to find their replacement home during the reporting period. Because of COVID and a housing shortage/price escalation it has not been easy. Five HAP applicants are pending Tri-Party Agreements to be executed and are expected to be under construction by the end of the year. The County is facing a supply shortage for pre-cast concrete due to COVID and has reported that they anticipate receiving the materials this month.

#### Houston - Buyout Program

The city recently submitted app. \$11.5M in draws which we anticipate approving in October and reflect 50% expenditure. In addition, the city has requested, and the GLO will likely approve a 2nd contract extension until April 2023 to accommodate 2 projects which entail URA/moving tenants over the next 12 months, one of which is a joint-funded Harvey Buyout Project. The GLO anticipates that the city will complete all activities and expend by April 2023.
