This Action Plan will be used by TDHCA, the agency designated by the Governor to administer these funds, and ORCA to provide CDBG funding for housing, infrastructure, public service, public facility, and business needs in the 29-county area directly impacted by Hurricane Rita on September 24, 2005. These funds will assist with long term recovery efforts and infrastructure restoration.

Recovery Needs:

GENERAL INFORMATION:

>The Texas General Land Office (GLO) continues working toward the completion of the Rita Disaster Recovery efforts. GLO has consolidated both the Housing and Non-Housing Disaster Recovery Activities under a single agency. During the current reporting period (April 1 &ndash June 30, 2012) the Round 1 Rita program had expenditures of \$4,662.50 which bring the program expenditures to date up to \$73,401,426.66 or 99.94% of the total grant allocation. GLO continues to work closely with Housing and Non-Housing grant recipients to complete their funded activities and hopes to have all currently funded projects completed by the third calendar quarter of 2012. >NON-HOUSING ACTIVITIES:

>There have been nearly one hundred (100) Infrastructure and Non-Housing COG grants awarded under Round 1 Rita recovery totaling approximately \$30.5 million. As of the end of this reporting period, all but five (5) of those grantee contracts have been administratively closed by GLO and any unutilized funds have been de-obligated. Construction activities are completed in the final five (5) grants, and closeout documents have been submitted to GLO for review, approval and Administrative Closeout. Expenditures through June 30, 2012 for Rita Round 1 Non-Housing Activities total approximately \$30.5 million, or 99.96% of the amount funded. HOUSING ACTIVITIES:

>There have been four (4) Housing grants awarded under Round 1 Rita recovery totaling approximately \$40.1 million. As of the end of this reporting period, two (2) of the contracts has been administratively closed by GLO and any unutilized funds have been de-obligated. The de-obligated funding reduces the current budgeted amount for Housing Activities to \$30.2 million. The final two Housing grants have completed all construction activities, but remain open for final expenditures for housing insurance costs. Those final costs are scheduled for payment in September, 2012 at which time the grants should be closed. Expenditures through June 30, 2012 for Rita Round 1 Housing Activities total approximately \$39.1 million, or 99.92% of the current amount funded.

Direct Benefit (Persons)

As a result of Hurricane Rita, a number of damaged and destroyed homes were cleared and removed from the damaged properties. A portion of the debris created by these demolition activities has been dumped at an open lot located at 24942 Highway 73, Jefferson County, Texas. The debris has been identified as an environmental hazard by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality and cited as a blighted area by Jefferson County through a County resolution. The debris, including blue roofing material and housing material, began accumulating at the site shortly after Hurricane Rita which occurred in September 2005 and before Hurricane Ike hit the region in September 2008. The contractor will provide for the removal of the accumulated demolition debris at a cost not to exceed \$1,200,000 in order to eliminate the blighted area and the threat to public health and safety it has created.
