#### **Disaster Damage:**

This Action Plan will be used by TDHCA, the agency designated by the Governor to administer these funds, and ORCA to provide CDBG funding for housing, infrastructure, public service, public facility, and business needs in the 29-county area directly impacted by Hurricane Rita on September 24, 2005. These funds will assist with long term recovery efforts and infrastructure restoration.

#### **Recovery Needs:**

Housing activities will include but are not limited to single & multifamily acquisition, demolition, repair, rehabilitation, reconstruction and new construction as appropriate for the specific local needs to address damage as a result of Hurricane Rita. Flood buyouts of homes damaged by Hurricane Rita in which the owner will repurchase a home are considered housing activities. Funding provided for these housing activities will be in the form of a grant. Non-Housing activities will include but are not limited to FEMA Infrastructure Grant Program match, FEMA Hazard Mitigation Grant Program match (including drainage projects, flood buyouts in which the property is converted into open, undeveloped land, and safe-room and community storm shelters), Natural Resource & Conservation Service flood and drainage projects, roads and bridges, water control facilities, water & wastewater facilities, buildings and equipment, hospitals and other medical facilities, utilities, parks and recreational facilities, debris removal, public/community shelters and loan funds for businesses. All of these activities must be related to addressing damages created by Hurricane Rita.

### **Activity Description:**

As a supplement to their Hurricane Ike recovery grant DRS220219, GLO#12-544-000-6819, Contractor shall construct a clay berm at a length of approximately twenty-four thousand sixty linear feet (24,060 I.f.), install select sand fill, and dune vegetation over an approximate project length of seventy-six thousand seven hundred seventy linear feet (76,770 I.f.) (Inclusive of the length above) and install drainage structures. Proposed improvements will protect the healthy marshland areas from salt water inundation, slow the rate of shoreline retreat and marshland destruction and protect residents from dangerous storm surges in the future. Construction shall take place from the western boundary of the McFaddin National Wildlife Refuge to the Perkins Levee on the Jefferson County Coastline. Proposed improvements shall protect the healthy marshland areas from salt water inundation, slow the rate of shoreline retreat and marshland destruction and protect residents from dangerous storm surges in the future. Improvements are planned as a result of Hurricanes Rita and Ike coastal area damage.
